The following rules apply to the student's enrollment in the remedial course system:

- The student will study the courses (541-543) according to the remedial course system. The student may be allowed to study only one course of three credit hours based on their grades in the program-related courses on their undergraduate transcript and the opinion of the interview committee formed for this purpose. Remedial courses are not counted among the program's approved hours.
- 2. Students study remedial courses for one semester, and may not register for the program's approved hours until they complete the remedial courses and achieve a GPA of at least 3.
- 3. Students who do not achieve the required grade under the remedial course system cannot enroll in the approved hours in the program, and they cannot re-enroll.
